STRIKE COMMANDER within striking distance off the inside, lacked a closing bid. MAJANI within striking distance in the three path, had nothing left late. OUTA SPACE forced the pace while saving ground, held on well to the stretch and tired. TAKE THE A TRAIN reserved early, was wide around the turn and was no threat. STOLE outsprinted early along the inside, was no factor. PUNCH broke in the air, recovered to race within striking distance but tired. RENEGE was no threat. EL BRETTE was outrun along the inside. HIT IT HARD hesitated at the start and was outrun.

MEDAGLIA D'ORO sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, relinquished control midway on the backstretch then fell back a bit into the second turn, re-bid along the rail midway on that bend, took another lead just past the eighth pole and pulled clear under urging. U S S TINOSA stalked outside early then bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, continued three wide into the stretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. SIPHONIC stalked the winner off the rail early, bid between horses and took a short lead on the backstretch, inched away between calls into the second turn, dueled between rivals on that bend and into the stretch, then weakened in the final furlong but held third. TRACEMARK saved ground close up early, fell back on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and passed a pair of tiring rivals. PUERTO BANUS stalked the leaders off the rail or outside, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. SHAH JEHAN reserved close up off the rail early, split horses on the backstretch, continued just off the inside, angled in leaving the second turn and had little left.

MEDAGLIA D'ORO quickly showed in front, responded when joined from the inside by the winner, made the pace while in hand and battled gamely while between rivals through the stretch. SUNDAY BREAK (JPN) raced close up while three wide, ranged up three wide to join the leaders on the second turn, and finished gamely while outside in the drive. SAARLAND was bumped after the start, dropped back early, advanced four wide on the second turn and stayed on well outside. BLUE BURNER raced five wide on the first turn, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. IWIN raced inside early on, dropped back and drifted out while tiring entering the stretch. NOKOMA was steadied when in tight quarters between rivals entering the first turn, chased the pace along the inside for three quarters and tired. LAISSEZALLER was bumped after the start, raced wide on the first turn, was pulled up on the backstretch and was vanned off.

PROUD CITIZEN, lightly bumped at the start by HARLAN'S HOLIDAY, moved up soon after to race in closest attendance to WAR EMBLEM four wide, loomed a strong threat outside that one when straightened into the stretch, then wasn't a match in the final furlong while gamely saving second. PERFECT DRIFT, in hand from the outset while closer than usual along the inside, remained inside while tracking WAR EMBLEM, was checked for several strides when lacking room in behind that one at the three-sixteenths pole, altered course outside the winner, then came up empty in the final furlong. MEDAGLIA D'ORO bobbled at the start and was bumped by ESSENCE OF DUBAI when that one came out, worked his way forward between rivals four or five wide on the backstretch and around the second turn, swung out seven or eight wide entering the upper stretch, bumped with ESSENCE OF DUBAI leaving the three-sixteenths pole and was finished. REQUEST FOR PAROLE, forwardly placed in hand while four wide, was asked for his best approaching the final quarter, remained in behind the leaders and failed to respond.
