

5 FURLONGS. (Turf) (.533) 4TH RUNNING OF THE TEXAS GLITTER. Purse \$75,000 THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, February 11. \$750 to enter. \$75,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes since August 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race since August 1, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entrybox by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. SALMANAZAR sprinted to clear lead in opening stages and remained comfortable leading the way, came under pressure in the turn, repelled bids under strong hand ride, showed whip and tapped couple times, kept sharp and held clear. SHANGROYAL got bumped hard at the start and quickly recovered to race behind the leader, edged up to challenge SALMANAZAR near the quarter pole, could not gain equal terms but kept on in striking distance upper stretch, lacked kick for winner, nipped rival for place. BARBAROSSA raced in tracking position just off the leader, dropped to rail past the quarter pole, lacked clear path upper stretch, angled in and under all out drive in late stages, needed more to reach winner, got nipped for place. BOURBON CURRENCY raced in range then forced to check at the three eighths pole, lost momentum, raced near the back at head of the lane, made mild rebid along the outside. CLOUDED JUDGEMENT broke well from the outside then lacked early foot to continue near the lead, raced in range then finished evenly in the lane. WILDCAT'S LEGACY hustled up along the rail then set down driving three to four wide in the lane, showed response but needed more then hopped some tracks in deep stretch. DIAL ONE raced in the back, hustled up along the far outside, continued wide bid in the lane. REED KAN got bumped bit at the start, chased early pace then came up empty in the lane.
