1 1/16 MILES. (1.39) 5TH RUNNING OF THE CALIFORNIA CUP DERBY. Purse \$200,000 (plus \$1,035 Other Sources) FOR GOLDEN STATE SERIES ELIGIBLE CALIFORNIA BRED OR CALIFORNIA SIREB THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each to accompany the nomination, closed Thursday, February 8, 2018 with 20 or by supplementary nomination of \$25,000 at time of entry for NonGolden State Series eligible horses or \$4,000 for Golden State Series eligible horses. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$110,000 to the winner, \$38,000 to second, \$22,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth, \$4,000 to sixth, \$4,000 to seventh and \$4,000 to eighth. 124 lbs. Winners of a Graded Stake, 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs., Two races other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

HECK YEAH dueled outside a rival then inched away on the backstretch, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, kicked clear and held under left handed urging. VIOLENT RIDGE chased inside then off the rail leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and outside a foe into the stretch and finished well. CONTINENTAL DIVIDE fanned five wide into the first turn, angled in and chased off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a rival late for the show. FIRE WHEN READY three deep on the first turn, stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn, angled in entering the stretch and was edged for third. CAMPAIGNER five wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then four wide into the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. BLACK SITE four wide into the first turn, chased between horses then a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened. HARDBOOT squeezed at the start, settled inside, split horses on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. FAVERSHAM fanned four wide into the first turn, settled outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. INTIMIDATE angled in and dueled inside then stalked along the rail, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. KALEIDOSCOPE KID fanned six wide into the first turn, angled in and settled outside then off the rail, angled in again leaving the second turn and failed to menace. LUCKY ROMANO drifted out into the first turn, angled in and stalked inside, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the drive.
