SKY DEFENCE forced three wide into the first turn, moved forward to force the pace taking over a narrow lead about the eleven-sixteenths pole, vied between runners to the far turn, edged clear into upper stretch, was challenged late but gamely held off DEPUTY'S ECHO, who settled between runners through the early going, switched out four wide coming past the quarter pole to commence a bid, drew along the flank of the aforementioned a sixteenth out but could not get past. LOOKS TO SPARE settled off the pace racing off the inside, bided time into the far turn then shifted out five wide past the quarter pole, got up for show honors. PAIN AND MISERY switched out heading up the backstretch about four to five wide, came in a bit on the far turn racing three to four wide through that bend, needed more in the lane. BLUE AZUL led rivals into the first turn to set the early pace then attended from inside while ceding the lead, weakened in the lane. L. A. TOWER switched outside the pacesetter leaving the first turn to stalk from well outside in about the five path up the backstretch, shifted in a bit for the far turn, gave way in the stretch. OH SO REGAL was rated in behind along the rail early, came up empty when asked for run.
