

ABOUT 1 MILE. (Turf) (1.41) 38TH RUNNING OF THE DIXIE POKER. Purse \$60,000 (includes \$37,500 LTBA Supplement) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Free nomination by Saturday, February 17. \$300 to enter; \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,200 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over on the turf since January 3 allowed 2 lbs, \$25,000 at a mile or over on the turf since December 3 allowed 4 lbs, \$20,000 of such a race since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be shown through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum field size for the Dixie Poker Ace SStakes will be determined by rail setting. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings on the turf. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile.).

TRUST FACTOR was rated just off the pace on the inside, cut the corner into the stretch, poked his head into a hole inside of MORNING MISCHIEF outside the three-sixteenths, was bumped hard by that foe and lost action while brushing the rail, continued to try and get through along the rail while crowded by the aforementioned rival, rubbed saddles into the final furlong, squeezed through near the sixteenth-pole, chased the runner-up determinedly to the wire and got up. EXTRA CREDIT stumbled at the start then bumped with a rival and was carried in, saved ground on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was roused in the two path on the far turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, closed strongly into the final furlong, took the lead at the sixteenth-pole but was denied while clear for the place. MORNING MISCHIEF broke in at the start, went to the front, raced inside to the two path on the first turn, set the pace, vied in the two path on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came in and bumped TRUST FACTOR soundly nearing the three-sixteenths, kept that foe in tight quarters into the final furlong, battled into the final sixteenth then weakened but held the show. ZARB'S GIFT raced in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the far turn, was asked while taking the lead at the three-sixteenths, lost the advantage at the sixteenth-pole and also weakened then just missed the show. GENTLMENS AGREEMENT bumped with a rival at the start and was carried in, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, took an awkward stride leaving the backstretch, was roused while inside on the far turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, chased under a drive into the final furlong and was out-kicked. GRANDE BASIN moved his head just as the gate opened and was off a step slow, quickly angled to the inside, settled along the rail, was urged along on the far turn, moved into a good striking position in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. MAGEEZ rounded the first turn in the two path, came out onto the backstretch, lagged at the rear on the outside, was urged along in the two to three path on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch under the whip, moved out at the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. BERNIESTRIKE went around the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside, was urged along in the two then three path on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch and tired. LET US BE GLAD was carried in at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
