

1 1/8 MILES. (1.473) 93RD RUNNING OF THE NEW ORLEANS HANDICAP. Grade II. Purse \$400,000 FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$400 by Saturday, March 10. \$2,000 to enter, \$2,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$10,000 will be accepted by 12:00 noon on Thursday, March 15 which shall include all fees. \$400,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weights: Thursday, March 15. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The New Orleans Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, March 10, 2018 with 16 nominations.

GOOD SAMARITAN dropped well behind early, raced in the two path on the first turn, lagged at the back while unhurried, was asked near the half-mile pole, rounded most of the far turn in the two path, angled four wide to avoid the injured rival inside the five-sixteenths, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed strongly under a hand ride on the outside, was given one tap of a down-turned whip coming to the furlong marker, took the advantage shortly thereafter then moved clear under a mild hand ride to win handily. HOLLYWOOD HANDSOME moved out early, went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, took the lead before the three-sixteenths, lost the advantage at the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while well clear for the place. SCUBA was taken in hand early, raced inside on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, moved up with five furlongs to run then made a bid, vied in the three then two path under urging on the far turn, dropped back under the whip in upper stretch and weakened but was clear for the show. HAN SENSE rounded the first turn in the two path, tracked the pace on the outside, moved up near the five-eighths pole then made a bid, vied four then three wide on the far turn, dropped back under a drive at the three-sixteenths then moved out under the whip and tired. THE PLAYER was hustled to the lead, set the pace on the inside while well rated, was challenged midway down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, took a bad step at the five-sixteenths and was pulled up then vanned off.
