Free nomination by Saturday, March 17. \$300 to enter, \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,200 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over since January 31 allowed 2 lbs, \$25,000 at a mile or over since December 31 allowed 4 lbs, \$20,000 at a mile or over since then allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Star Guitar Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest lifetime earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. MOBILE BAY broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced to make a bid in the three path on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, edged clear outside the furlong marker and proved best under steady urging. MAGEEZ rounded the first turn in the two path, lagged at the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and finished with late energy to just get the place. UNDERPRESSURE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and finished willingly to just miss the place. PADDY O' LIONEL raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn and lacked the needed response. GRANDE BASIN settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. MORNING MISCHIEF set the clear pace on the inside, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, lost the lead to the winner in upper stretch and weakened. THEORYINTOPRACTICE went around the first turn in the two path, tracked the pace, dropped back at the half-mile pole, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and came up empty. NUBIN RIDGE went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased in the two path on the far turn and capitulated.
