

1 $\frac{1}{16}$ MILES. (Turf) (1.38) 32ND RUNNING OF THE PALM BEACH. Grade III. Purse \$100,000 THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, February 18. \$1,000 to enter. \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 120 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on turf allowed 2 lbs., a stakes race, 4 lbs., two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth) (Rail at 96 feet).

MARAUD was off to good start and raced behind leader in first turn, was allowed to settle behind SPEED FRANCO through the backstretch, edged closer then tapped along past the quarter pole, put to drive top stretch, responded and roused forward to draw on equal terms with SPEED FRANCO a furlong out, raced heads apart, dug in determinedly and edged by nearing the wire. SPEED FRANCO led the way in the first turn, set the pace saving ground and remained comfortable on top leading into far turn, challenged upper stretch by MARAUD with outside running HAWKISH in striking distance, held off latter rival then duelled heads apart with MARAUD, fought gamely from inside position, got edged out nearing wire. THERAPIST was unsettled in the gate, backed out then stubborn to reload, got away ok then settled saving ground along the rail through the backstretch, asked for more and got back even response in far turn, kept under a ride then finished with kick nearing wire to gain share. HAWKISH sat off early pace, loomed closer along outside near the quarter pole, raced in striking distance a furlong out, lacked needed kick to gain the lead then flattened out. NEEPAWA raced two wide in the first turn then nicely rated through the backstretch, came under a ride, raced in strong contention but lacked needed kick for serious impact. RENAISSANCE FROLIC raced under slight restraint to take off early pace while saving ground, hustled up for response in far turn then failed to move on in the lane. EYE OF A JEDI dwelt at the start, trailed in back and never recovered from poor start.
