BROTHER BOB settled off the dueling leaders, was asked to gain on them at the 5/16ths pole, angled 3wd into far turn, wore down leading foe in he stretch and gained the advantage with only . CURRENTLY KRAZY dueled for the early lead from the 2 path, cleared his inside rival into the far turn, raced along the rail through the turn, had a clear lead by open lengths until the 1/16th pole, but just got passed approaching the wire. RACING RAY race in the 3 path all the way around, was asked for effort at the 1/2 mile pole, gained ground while wide in stretch. CAPTAIN HADLEY saved ground on both turns before quickly gaining in stretch, but was left with too much to do. FUSAICHI SAMURAI was last early, angled out into the backstretch stayed wide through the far turn and gained ground in the stretch but did not threaten the leaders. EIGHTEENCHARACTERS dueled for the lead along the rail, lost the lead at the 1/4 pole and subsequently weakened in the stretch. PEAKNATASTAR stalked from the 2 path, dropped to last at the 5/16th pole and passed a tired rival in the stretch. MISSING GROOM was 3wd first turn, gained ground 4wd down backstretch, but tired afterwards.
