ARMY MULE away without apparent mishap, settled into the two path, was reserved drafting behind the pacesetter for the opening half and a little beyond, paused in hand before taking up what turned out to be temporary residence along the inside route in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, was given his cue a sixteenth later, and even while angling three wide into the stretch, was still able to muster up a robust burst of speed, emerged at the end of the run through the furlong grounds well clear of the others, and stayed thus so, driving, but not fully extended crossing the finish line. AWESOME SLEW stepped onto the turn from the four path, continued along in midpack during the run around the bend, got sent outward until about seven wide after spinning into the lane, finished well to garner the place, although no match. GREAT STUFF three wide onto the turn, swung seven wide exiting it and went on to rally for the show. SKYLER'S SCRAMJET forwardly placed three wide, was let out shortly after completing the half, entered the stretch and was outfinished. PETROV showed no ill effects after bobbling right after the field had been sent on its way, pursued the front runner stationed in path four on the turn, lightly urged, was put to more feverish handling angling six wide for the drive home, lacked the needed late response. FAVORABLE OUTCOME reserved three wide for the opening half, was driven five wide into the lane, made no late headway. FELLOWSHIP had the rider grab hold after bobbling at the break, arrived at the half mile pole stacked five wide, had the rider go to work before the five-sixteenths marker, got sent out into path eight making his way to the wire, had no impact. DO SHARE took up the chase from the two path, failed to pick it up real estate when asked for more at the three-eighths pole. RED DRAGON TATTOO away alertly, remained forwardly placed, got guided into the two path, showed the way, accompanied by GREEN GRATTO to the outside, got swallowed up by the top one as the pair made their way onto the head of the stretch and faltered. SPARTIATIAS underwent a ground-saving journey, got set down a short distance from the quarter pole, failed to fire appreciably. GREEN GRATTO spared three wide for command for the opening half before giving way.
