

1 MILE. (Turf) (1.35) DANGER'S HOUR S. Purse \$100,000 OUTER TURF FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2017-18 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 on the turf in 2018 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races in 2018 allowed 6 lbs.; of a race in 2018 allowed 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and state-bred allowance races not considered in allowances.) The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. A presentation will be to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 24, 2018 with 25 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

FIRE AWAY settled three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge through the final furlong taking command nearing the sixteenth marker, then inched away to the finish kept busy to the wire. PROJECTED (GB) settled three wide at the tail of the field, remained patiently handled as the field began to contract nearing the quarter pole, tipped out to the four path put to coaxing before angling five to six wide into upper stretch roused for the drive, closed well outside to be along for the place honors too late to issue a threat to the aforementioned foe. MO TOWN brushed the near side stall at the start, raced forwardly placed inside and was in a bit tight into the first turn as HIT IT ONCE MORE grew rank under restraint to the outside as MACAGONE crossed over to the three path, came under a snug hold and pulled on the bit a tad rank through the first turn before settling three wide into the backstretch in closest aim of the leader, tucked to the two path seven-sixteenths from home, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths latched on MACAGONE as SECRETARY OF WAR ranged up to the outside, swung three wide into upper stretch seizing narrow command, dug in under a drive under threat from SECRETARY OF WAR, repelled that rival successfully nearing the sixteenth marker when overtaken by the eventual winner, then ran on to preserve the show honors. SECRETARY AT WAR bumped at the start by BOLTING who recovered from a bobble, raced three wide through the opening bend before settling four then five wide down the backstretch tracking from mid pack, came under light coaxing at the seven-sixteenths tucking three wide and commenced a steady advance through the turn to latch on the top pair five-sixteenths from home when put to further coaxing, angled five wide into upper stretch looming to the outside of MO TOWN to the eighth pole, got gradually shaken off in the final furlong flattening out a bit in the late stages and held for the last major share. CONQUEST PANTHERA just off the inside near the rear of the field, tucked inside at the seven-sixteenths, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, rallied up the rail with a mild bid to the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. HIT IT ONCE MORE came in filling the space briefly vacated by the bobbling BOLTING and bumped with that rival, came under hustling to be forwardly placed in the two path and was taken in hand growing rank in a bit tight between foes as MACAGONE cross to the three path into the first turn, remained a bit rank stargazing his way three wide into the backstretch before settling four wide in range of the front, tucked three wide at the seven-sixteenths, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths, continued four wide into upper stretch, stayed on through the stretch but was outkicked. GREAT WIDE OPEN (IRE) pinched back lightly between rivals at the start, tracked the pace along the inside, came under a ride midway on the far turn, swung three wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late going. MACAGONE established the front and showed the way crossing three then two wide into the first turn, settled in hand patiently handled until nearing the five-sixteenths, came under pressure from a pair, got headed nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home and weakened in the final furlong. BOLTING bobbed at the start bumping SECRETARY OF WAR then got bumped by HIT IT ONCE MORE, tracked from just off the inside from just off the pace, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home and tired.
