

1 1/8 MILES. (Turf) (1.401) 30TH RUNNING OF THE KENTUCKY UTILITIES TRANSYLVANIA, Grade III. Purse \$150,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$4,500 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over on the turf, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Transylvania will be limited to fourteen with two also eligibles. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Nominations closed on Wednesday, March 21, 2018 with 40 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile and One-Sixteenth on the main track. (Rail at 15 feet).

ANALYZE IT settled in hand three deep, came under a ride with three furlongs to run, took over entering the stretch and kicked away. CAPTIVATING MOON was allowed to settle, came five wide to make his bid, was bumped and forced further out entering the stretch, recovered quickly and finished well to just earn the place. ADMIRALTY PIER was allowed to settle four wide between horses, angled out and loomed a danger entering the stretch, but flattened and settled for the minor award. DRAGON DREW was nearest the pace off of the inside, drew even between horses leaving the second turn, but weakened slightly during the drive and gave way. MARAUD contended between horses, came three wide but failed to sustain the drive. TIGERS RULE was unhurried, moved up on the second turn, steadied in traffic entering the stretch, shifted out between runners, was bumped hard as BEER PRESSURE retreated, angled out and made a mild rally once clear. FUNNY DUCK was allowed to settle between horses, angled out to make a mild bid, but failed to make headway. GOLDEN DRAGON saved ground to no avail. KING VALERO was hustled along five wide, came up empty on the second turn, was bothered entering the stretch and faded. TAP DADDY settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch, was bumped and steadied between rivals and came up empty thereafter. BEER PRESSURE sprinted well clear to set the pace, came up empty after a mile, stopped entering the stretch, drifted about in full retreat, bumped TIGERS RULE hard near the three-sixteenths pole as he continued to faded.
