

**7 FURLONGS. ( 1211 ) 17TH RUNNING OF THE MADISON. Grade I Purse \$300,000 FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$9,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$9,000 to fifth and \$6,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 3 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade I or Grade II since December 25, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Madison will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies or mares pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I–II–III), then highest 2017–2018 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Wednesday, March 21, 2018 with 35 nominations.

FINLEY'SLUCKYCHARM pressed the pace early along the five path, swung into the six path entering the lane, took over command down the lane, dug in and gamely prevailed from between horses in the final stages. MISS SUNSET stalked the pace early from the six path, fanned into the seven path in the turn, made a late bid three wide down the lane, dug in and missed in the final stages three wide. LEWIS BAY was well placed early while off the rail, waited for room nearing the quarter pole, fanned into the seven path entering the lane, made a bid four wide down the lane, dug in but gamely missed in the final stages. AMERICAN GAL set the pace early along the three path, stayed in the three path entering the lane, continued one down the lane from the inside while slightly drifting out and reluctantly gave in during the late stages. SALTY was bumped at the start and early on, raced back from the four path, fanned into the eight path entering the lane, rallied down the lane and was rolling late while six wide in the final stages. AMI'S MESA was back early on from the six path, fanned into the eight path in the turn, made a bid five wide late while gaining in the late stages. TEQUILITA tracked the pace early along the three path, swung into the six path in the turn with some minor gain in the stretch run. MS LOCUST POINT was in tight early on, chased the pace from the four path, stayed in the four path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. NATURAL WONDER was never a threat. TERESA Z was never involved.
