

ABOUT 7 FURLONGS. (1.25) 33RD RUNNING OF THE BEAUMONT PRESENTED BY KEENELAND SELECT. Grade III. Purse \$150,000 FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$4,500 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner plus 10 Road To The Kentucky Oaks Points, \$30,000 to second plus 4 Road To The Kentucky Oaks Points, \$15,000 to third plus 2 Road To The Kentucky Oaks Points, \$7,500 to fourth plus 1 Road To The Kentucky Oaks Point, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade II stakes or \$58,000 twice, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Beaumont will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I–II–III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 21, 2018 with 37 nominations.

GAS STATION SUSHI was bothered a bit at the start and was well placed early on, was blocked and waited nearing the five sixteenth pole, altered in for room then back out nearing the lane, fanned into the five path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, drove past the leaders three wide, inched clear and held sway in the final stages. KELLY'S HUMOR trailed the field early on, swung into the six path in the turn, began a rally into the lane, drifted in and out in the stretch and was gaining in the late stages with a hurry. UPPERCUT came out at the start, set the pace early on, angled off the rail in the turn, was under a long drive in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. HAPPY LIKE A FOOL stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. DREAM IT IS pressed the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn, was under a long drive down the lane but faltered late in the stretch drive. UPSET BREWING was back early on, raced on the rail entering the lane, made a bid in the stretch but leveled out late in the drive. IN THE MOOD came out at the start, chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn and faded down the lane. SUNNY SKIES came out at the start and was done early. SUMMER SUNDAY stalked the pace early on, fanned into the five path in the turn and was empty in the stretch.
