1 MILE. (Turf) (1.332) 30TH RUNNING OF THE APALACHIAN PRESENTED BY JAPAN RACING ASSOCIATION. Grade II. Purse \$200,000 FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth, and \$4,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over on the turf, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Appalachian will be limited to fourteen with two also eligibles. In the event that more than fourteen fillies pass the entry box, these fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 21, 2018 with 41 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile on the main track. (Rail at 15 feet).

RUSHING FALL settled in hand in the garden spot, cruised to the leaders at will leaving the turn, shook off the challenge of DADDY IS A LEGEND a furlong out and drew clear to score with something left. THEWAYIAM (FR) was jostled between horses at the start, tucked in to save ground while never far back, came under a ride leaving the second turn, shifted out a bit and split rivals, kicked on well once uncovered and was making up ground. GOODTHINGSTAKETIME (IRE) was allowed to settle, advanced between horses five wide through the second turn, tipped out further in the upper stretch to clear sailing and continued on well to earn the show. DADDY IS A LEGEND broke in a tangle and was away well behind her field, was taken in hand and settled five wide, launched a sweeping move and loomed large entering the stretch, but faltered in the final furlong and gave way. BEACH WALTZ bumped with a rival leaving the gate, was forwardly placed three wide, but weakened between runners into the lane and faded. HEAVENLY LOVE was bumped at the start, was unhurried into stride, wheeled out leaving the second turn and improved position while failing to seriously threaten. SHE'S PRETTY LUCKY was close up toward the inside, got through but lacked the needed late response. LOUNGE ACT opened clear to set the pace along the inside, was collared on the second turn, and gave way from tight quarters through the stretch. DIXIE MOON failed to respond.
