1 1/8 MILES. (1.452) 64TH RUNNING OF THE PETER PAN. Grade III. Purse \$350,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$350 each which should accompany the nominations; \$1,750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 3 lbs.; of \$60,000 other than state-bred stake at a mile or over or three races allowed 5 lbs.; of two races allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and state-bred allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 28, 2018 with 23 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

BLENDED CITIZEN brushed the off side stall at the start getting away half a beat slow, raced three to four wide down the backstretch near the rear of the field, tipped out to the six path with six furlongs to go, tucked three then briefly two wide through the far turn, came under a ride seven-sixteenths out, angled six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive steadily gaining through the final furlong to issue a challenge inside the sixteenth marker, took over seventy yards from home and inched away to the finish kept to task. CORE BELIEFS stumbled at the start recovering to vie inside a trio three then two wide in hand down the backstretch, vied inside a pair through the far turn tucked to the inside as GOTTA GO was shaken off half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, dug in under a near sided stick edged away before shying out from it a furlong from home, dug in under growing threat to the outside, got collared seventy yards from the finish and was forced to settle for the place honors while clear of the rest. JUST WHISTLE vied between foes four then three wide among a quartet early on and then a trio through the turn, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home clinging to a narrow lead tucked to the two path, floated four wide into upper stretch headed for command, fought on to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. HIGH NORTH six then five wide down the backstretch under rating albeit vying among a quartet, tucked three wide into the turn and vied outside a pair patiently handled until set down spinning five wide into upper stretch, then weakened in the drive. ZING ZANG chased just off the inside until tucked inside with six furlongs to go, came under coaxing at the nine-sixteenths, tipped out to be five wide midway on the turn, went seven wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. GOTTA GO vied seven then six paths off the rail with a trio to his inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide into the turn with nine-sixteenths remaining, got shaken off and came under coaxing three furlongs from home, continued to fade, swung four wide into upper stretch and tired.
