CLASSIC ROCK broke well and held slim lead in initial stages before edging away to comfortable margin on top, continued to lead the way saving ground near the inside, challenged for top spot by CAUTIOUS GIANT just past the five sixteenths pole, dueled heads apart entering the stretch, pinned ears back and tilted head toward rival to intimidate sharp running foe, dug in gamely from inside, held the edge and refused to relinquish control, wore CAUTIOUS GIANT down and cleared on top nearing wire. CAUTIOUS GIANT was rated in contention running through the backstretch, made move for CLASSIC ROCK midway through the turn, dueled heads apart past the quarter pole, continued to dig in gamely from outside position racing well clear over rest, all out in deep stretch, could not get by sharp winner, finished clearly second best. DIAMOND BACHELOR was well reserved racing in the back along far outside, dropped inside and put to drive along rail, got up for share. EARLY ENTRY was forwardly placed racing just off CLASSIC ROCK, lost position in the turn then appeared all out and tired in the lane. MR ATILA was positioned in range going through the backstretch, under a ride racing off the top trio in the turn but could not move on, faded. MILLIONAIRE RUNNER was off slow at the start, raced near the back then drifted out wide in the lane.
