By subscription of \$100 to accompany the nomination by Midnight Saturday, April 28, 2018 with an additional \$750 to enter and \$1,000 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,500 will be accepted at the time of entry in addition to the races nomination, entry and start fees. 100% of all supplemental monies will be included in the \$50,000 guaranteed purse. \$50,000 guaranteed, of which 55% goes to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 4% to fifth, and 2% sixth through eighth. Weight: 120 lbs. Non-winners of \$55,000 in 2017-2018 allowed, 3 lbs. Non-winners of \$27,500 in 2017-2018 allowed 5 lbs. Non-winners of \$12,000 in 2017-2018 allowed 7 lbs. Preference will be based on 2017-2018 earnings as recorded by Equibase at time of entry. Field limited to 11 starters.

HERE'S HANNAH away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from along the rail in the run down the backstretch, was briefly overtaken entering the final turn, but battled gamely through the turn, to assume command leaving the turn, and was all out to hold off a fast closing GIGI JEAN in the closing strides to prevail. GIGI JEAN unhurried early while drifting back to trail, rallied smartly three wide entering the final turn, and closed with a rush four wide in the stretch drive while drifting in late to just miss. RAIDER settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, commenced her bid from along the inside entering the final turn, and finished willingly from along the rail in the drive in a solid effort. SUZETTE broke sharply and stalked the leaders into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied two wide from between rivals entering the final turn, and finished from between rivals while exchanging bumps with MY AUNT MO in deep stretch. MY AUNT MO settled off the early pace while racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn, and closed two out from the rail in the drive while exchanging bumps with SUZETTE. FIRST SUMMER lagged well off the early pace while racing just out from the rail entering the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn, and finished one out from the rail in the drive while unable to mount a serious bid. SEVENTIMES SEVENTY settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but failed to make a late impact while finishing two wide in the drive. ACHARNEMENT away well and duelled for the lead one out from the rail entering the first turn, forced the issue two wide in the run down the backstretch, held a slight advantage entering the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive.
