

1 1/8 MILES. (1.391) 8TH RUNNING OF THE EASY GOER. Purse \$150,000 FOR THREE YEARS OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,250 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The Purse to be divided as follows, \$87,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth, \$3,000 to sixth with the remaining \$3,000 to bedivided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over, allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred allowance at a mile or over, 6 lbs.; of such a race at a mile or over, 8 lbs. This field will be limited to 14 starters. High Weights Preferred. Ties will be broken by total 2017-18 earnings. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 26, 2018 with 32 Nominations.

PRINCE LUCKY just off the pace five then four wide down the backstretch, advanced tucked three wide into the turn and came under coaxing between foes three deep three furlongs from home among a quartet stacked across the track, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, rallied digging in between foes knocking heads through the final furlong and gamely got the decision in the final strides to the wire. RUGBYMAN four to five wide down the backstretch near the rear initially, commenced a four wide advance into the turn to stack outside a trio with three-eighths to go, swung five wide into upper stretch, dug in latching on the top pair a furlong from home, fought through to the finish in game fashion and just got the bob for the place honors. DARK VADER bobbed at the break recovering to prompt the leader to the outside from the four then three path down the backstretch, came under coaxing between rivals just inside the three-eighths tucked to the two path among a quartet, took over narrow command near the quarter pole and spun just off the inside at that station, dug in determined under assault from a pair through the final eighth and was bested in the last jumps while clear of the rest. MASK bobbed slightly at the start, chased two to three wide from mid pack coming under a ride three furlongs from home, cornered three wide at the head of the stretch, weakened in the late stages. SOUTACHE four wide in pursuit, got coaxed along at the three-eighths, angled seven wide at the top of the stretch, offered up a mild bid to the furlong grounds, then flattened out in the late going. BREAKING THE RULES stumbled at the start and recovered to chase three wide from mid pack, came under coaxing midway on the turn, angled six wide into upper stretch, shied out under near sided stick work twice straightened away for home before being corrected to the off side and weakened. LUNAR BEAUTY established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand from the two path under some prompting from DARK VADER to the outside, had the pressure intensify nearing the midway point on the bend as a trio of rivals now stacked to the outside and came under urging in response, got headed nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner for home and tired.
