

6 FURLONGS. (1.08) SMILE SPRINT S.Grade III. Purse \$250,000 THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, June 17. Any horse that has participated in a race at Gulfstream Park will be charged no fee to enter. All other horses shall pay \$2,500 to enter. \$250,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. An additional \$25,000 is available for registered Florida-bred starters, to be split 70% to the winner, 20% to second, and 10% to third. Weight: Three Year Olds 120 lbs; Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes since January 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race since January 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings.

XY JET broke alertly and quickly established clear lead, angled inside from outside position and widened on top still under slight restraint, raced two wide still unleashed midway through the turn then started to pick up pace, came out three wide top stretch, given cue and dug in gamely widening advantage a furlong out, lead on top shortened in deep stretch but kept to task under steady right handed drive and remained clear. REASON TO SOAR hustled up at the start, raced in tracking position behind XY JET, kept along in good spot along rail in the turn then swerved out entering top stretch which caused SPLASH RULES to clip heels, kept along with good response driving along outside and gained some ground on weakening winner in deep stretch. SWEETONHELADIES raced off the early pace, hustled up five wide in the turn, came in four then three wide under left handed drive, gained and secured share. PETROV was rated in early stages, roused three wide entering top stretch, came in path then raced in traffic and steadied slightly at the eighth pole, still in some traffic then cleared three wide then only under mild asking in deep stretch. SPLASH RULES was rated off the early pace then moved up to engage second flight racing four deep past the quarter pole then REASON TO SOAR swerved out approaching top stretch, clipped heels, lost momentum and weakened. MO CASH raced two wide in flight racing off the leader, kept under strong ride racing two wide in final furlong then gawey. CLASSIC ROCK gained contending position out of the gate, rated off quick pacesetter and continued to track XY JET racing between, hustled up leaving the backstretch then put to drive still between foes mid-way through turn, edged back from between turning for home, angled to rail then had no kick left in the drive. MR. JORDAN was restless when the gate broke open and off bit slow at the start, showed brief response then dropped back. THE RIDER OF .6 SPLASH RULES LODGED CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST .1 REASON TO SOAR FOR INTERFERENCE TOP STRETCH, STEWARDS FOUND .1 GUILTY OF SWERVING INTO PATH OF .6 SPLASH RULES CAUSING RIVAL TO CLIP HEELS, DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND AND PLACED FIFTH
