CHOIR DIRECTOR showed the most early speed to gain position in the two or three path, made all the running on a clear lead and held safe late. REVEREND SAM settled back off the pace racing three wide, rallied five wide into the lane and edged clear to gain the place while slowing cutting the winner's margin. GO GOLD saved ground midpack and made a mild late run in the drive. DUKE OF LUKE tucked inside to save ground, moved nearest the winner heading up the backstretch then lacked a final closing bid. ROCK CITY ROADHOG followed the pace from four wide, steadied outside a fallen rival into the far turn and had no late run. FROM DAY ONE was nearest the winner to midway up the backstretch racing three or four wide and weakened in the far turn. RENVYLE was void of any early speed to drop well back and could only close the gap on the field late. CRUZ'N JACK stalked the leaders from four wide in good position, appeared to fall with no apparent mishap into the far turn and then got up riderless and walked off under his own power. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the fallen horse and determined no action was necessary.
