CALGARY CAPER unhurried early while dropping back to trail, tipped four wide entering the backstretch the second time to commence his bid, continued three wide through the final turn, and closed determinedly two wide in the drive to prevail. BRAVE NATION settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail in the run down the backstretch the first time, maintained his position through the stretch the second time, and back into the backstretch, rallied smartly three wide entering the final turn, and closed determinedly three wide in deep stretch to just miss. SILENT EAGLE rushed to a clear lead entering the first turn and controlled the pace from the onset, rallied two wide entering the final turn while maintaining a narrow advantage, and battled gamely from along the rail in the drive in a game effort. DAY RAIDER settled off the early pace while racing three wide through the stretch the first time, continued to bid his time well off the early pace through the third turn and into the backstretch the final time, steadied midway to the final turn when trapped behind a tiring rival, rallied four wide through the final turn, and closed three out from the rail in the drive. HIGHWAY BOSS settled off the early pace while racing three wide into the backstretch the first time, raced three wide from between rivals in the run to the final turn, rallied three wide through the turn, and finished one out from the rail in the drive while lacking running room in mid stretch. SQUARE DANCER stalked the leader one out from the rail in the run down the backstretch the first time, gained a tracking trip two wide in the run down the backstretch the final time, rallied two wide through the final turn, but needed more late while finishing one out from the rail in the drive. LUCKY ENDING stalked the leader into the first turn while saving ground at the rail, continued to save ground throughout and gained a tracking trip entering the backstretch the final time, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, but was outfinished in the late going. CRAZY PROPHET settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch the first time, posted a mild bid from along the inside approaching the final turn, lacked room from along the rail midway through the turn, and failed to make a late impact while finishing three wide in the drive. MOONMAN settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail in the run down the backstretch the first time, began to lose position entering the backstretch the second time, and failed to respond when called upon. ABSOLUTELY STYLISH was off a step slow, and pinched back soon after the start, rushed up three wide entering the backstretch to gain a striking position, maintained that position while racing three wide into the third turn, but was through before reaching the midpoint of the backstretch the final time, and wasn't persevered with over the final furlong.
