DIDIA (ARG) bumped with an inner rival at the start, then took brushes from rivals on both sides in the early stages, laid off of the pace in the three path, fanned four wide in upper stretch, rallied with a clear ADVENTURING to catch in midstretch, ranged up to bid entering the final sixteenth, and drove clear. ADVENTURING stalked two wide, pressed around the far turn, bid entering the lane, drew clear in upper stretch, but was collared by an outer bidder at the sixteenth pole, and got bested. NEW YEAR'S EVE trailed in the two to three paths around the turns, shifted five wide in upper stretch with many lengths to find, and offered a good belated kick to close in on the top pair late. SHE CAN'T SING tracked in midpack two wide, took aim on the new leader three wide in upper stretch, but failed to progress before getting outkicked for minor rewards by an outer rival in midstretch, and yielded. GATHER AS YOU GO bumped with an outerrival at the start, set the pace along the inside, felt pressure from an outerrival around the far turn, got headed by that one entering the lane, and faded. RUSSIAN MAFIA laid unhurried three to two wide, and made little impact. ISLAND HIDEAWAY (GB) tracked along the inside, chased in upper stretch, and faded. TRAIL RIDGE ROAD saved ground off of the pace, but to no avail. NEW BOSS tracked three wide, but weakened in the four path turning for home. TROBAIRITZ steadied out of crowded quarters between horses in the opening stages, laid offof the pace two wide, saved ground around the far turn, but tired in upper stretch, and was eased through the final furlong.
