7 FURLONGS. (1.20) BAY SHORE S. Grade III Purse \$200,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake allowed 3 lbs.; of a sweepstake other than state bred in 2023 or two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance allowed 5 lbs.; A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 25, 2023 with 23 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

JOEY FRESHWATER coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, took over command swinging four wide into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to prevail. GILMORE traded a bump at the start with VICTORY WAY, chased three then two wide coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and closed well in the late stages to just get up in the very last jump for the place honors. VICTORY WAY traded a bump at the start with GILMORE, pressed the pace of PROVE RIGHT from the inside while just off the rail, tucked to the fence into the turn and came under coaxing at the three-eighths, advanced to take over narrow and brief command at the five-sixteenths, got headed spinning just off the inside for home, dug in under a drive running on and was nailed on the wire for the place honors. EXPECTED VALUE broke out at the start bumping PROVE RIGHT in the hindquarters, chased three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled seven wide at the head of the stretch and offered up late foot to close in concert with GILMORE to his inside but got out-finished in the late going. DAYDREAMING BOY five then four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, went six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was outkicked. PROVE RIGHT got bumped in the hind end at the start by EXPECTED VALUE, who broke outwards, established the front shortly after and showed the way in hand three then two wide under pressure to the inside from VICTORY WAY, came under coaxing at the three-eighths now under threat from flanking rivals, yielded the front with five-sixteenths to go and angled five wide into upper stretch in the midst of being shaken off, then weakened through to the finish. ARREBATO coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired.
