HERE MI SON G broke a step slow, laid off of the pace four wide, gained around the turn to bid for the lead at the five sixteenths pole, sparred outside of HOIST THE GOLD through the lane, and prevailed. HOIST THE GOLD shifted outside of foes down the backstretch to track five wide and outside of foes, tucked three wide in range of the top pair entering the turn, bid for the lead along with an outer rival at the five sixteenths pole, dueled gamely with that onethrough the lane, but was bested. GET HER NUMBER took an awkward stride before bumping with an inner rival at the start, trailed in the aftermath, advanced along the inside approaching the turn, remained under mild coaxing in the two to three paths around the turn, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch, and stayed on willingly to reach show at the wire. NAKATOMI bumped with an outer rival at the start, tracked three wide, tipped five wide in upper stretch while hanging on his left lead, shifted in a touch while changing over at the three sixteenths pole, then chased the embattled leading pair in the final furlong, gained show in the final sixteenth, but was nailed at the wire for that position. RUNCL ASSIC vied two wide, cleared to the rail entering the turn, vied with a trio of outer rivals turning for home, got headed entering the lane, and gave way through the final furlong, PRO OXIDANT vied three wide and between horses. backed off to stalk approaching the turn, pursued from the two path turning for home, then chased along the rail while lacking a bid. HEART RHYTHM raced close up along the inside, backed off to stalk down the backstretch, but faded turning for home. SPANKSTER failed to factor from the two to three paths around the turn. LONG RANGET ODDY vied four wide, tucked two wide entering the turn, vied between horses turning for home, and weakened in upper stretch. LEGIONN AIRE never got involved from the three to four paths.
