EXAULTED was antsy in the starting gate, dueled three wide into the first turnthen pressed from outside, lost touch with the leader but remained close up in the middle stages, re-engaged BOB AND JACKIE from outside on the far turn, took over in upper stretch and drove clear in the final sixteenth. IRIDEO (ARG) was fractious in the starting gate, unhurried in the beginning and steered inside, trailed while saving ground to the stretch, moved off the rail in the lane andfinished well to earn the place honors. BOB AND JACKIE dueled for the lead from inside into the first turn then inched ahead ar ound the bend, inched away from EXAULTED up thebackstretch, pressured again by that rival on the far turn, maintained a shortlead to the top of the lane, lost com mand in upper str etch, got outfinished in deepstretch and sav ed third. DU JOUR chased off the rail then got bumped to the four path entering the first turn, moved into the threepath around that bend, stalked outside a rival to the far turn, traveled two wide then spun three wide into the lane, got bumped at the three-sixteenths pole and finished evenly in the late sta ges. EARLS ROCK (IRE) br oke a step slow from inside, drifte dout and bumped rival into thefirst turn, stal ke dal ong the rail into the far turn, went two wide into the lane, bum ped DU JOUR again at three-sixteenths pole, finished evenly inside that rival through the furlong rounds and got edged for a minor award. VANZZY settled off the pace while moving to the rail, angled out on the far turn and came four wide int o the stretch butlacked further response.
