BLIND SPOT was bumped twice by the inside rival at the start, mov ed forward bet ween rivals under some coaxing then ranged up outside the lea ders three to four wide on the turn, struck the lead by the three-sixteenths, was clear in mid-stretch, lugge dout about the sixteenth poleunder left-handed encoura gement, just held. JIL LJITTERBUG bumped the outside rival twic eatthestart, settled off the pace, went three to four wide into the turn and was given some further encoura ge ment, move dout five wide coming to the top of thestretch, kicked into higher gear under stronger urging at that juncture, alteredoutside the drifting leader past the sixteenth pole, regained momentum seventy yar ds from home and was gaining but just missed. KAVALA broke a step slowly, was allowed to settle, swung seven wide for thestretch, gained late. DOLCE SOPRESA was fractious in the gate, got aw ay alertly but relinquished the leadand tracked in behind theleaders racing off the inside, continued thr ee to four wide on the turn, kept on ev enly in the stretch. STROKES (IRE) moved quickly to the lead, set the pace racing off the inside, was challenged by inside and outside rivals into and on the turn, weakene in the stretch. ANTIHERO lacked sufficient early speed, shifted in and passedinside rivals in thestr etch. FEARLESSANGEL raced off the leaders in the two to three path on the turn, lacked the needed latekick. COLLECTING FLATTER moved for ward inside, pressed the leader along the rail, took a narrow and brief lead at the three-eighths, steadied slightly near the five-sixteenths and quickly dropped back, failed to re-rally. FOLL OW ING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AS WELL AS AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF JILL JITTERBUG AGAINST BLIND SPOT ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH, THE LATTER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED SECOND BEHIND THE FORMER.
