OTTOMAN FLEET (GB) tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, remained patiently handled until given a nudge with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch advancing inside the leader straightened away to take command nearing the eighth pole, then edged clear under a drive to prevail. TIDE OF THE SEA established the front into the opening bend and crossed to the two path midway while pulling subtly on the bit and opening up before making his way to the railinto the backstretch, spurted away in hand inside and was waited with as the field took closer order into the far turn, came under light coaxing midway on the bend, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was collared near the eighth pole, ran on willingly to the finish to preserve the place honors on the line. CITY MAN three then two wide in pursuit, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and ran on to secure the show honors. ROCKEMPEROR (IRE) two to three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixt eenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then flattened out in the late stages. DYNADRIVE settled unhurried just off the inside near the rear of the field, tucked inside half a mile from home, remained patiently handled until setdown angled five to six wide into upper stretch, then improved position to the finish. KING CAUSE just off the inside tracking the spurting away leader in closest aim, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swungthree wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages in the drive. FORT WASHINGTON three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and came up empty. KEYSTONE FIELD chased three then two wide coming under brief coaxing at the three-eighths, got lightly urged taking the inside route into upper stretch and tired.
