MAKER'S CANDY broke out at the start bumping WHAT'S UP BRO, then got his lane taken away by RADIO RED and altered inwards, chased a long the inside, decided to tip out nearing the nine-sixteenths and had RADIO RED oblige tipping out and nudging LIFETIME OF CHANCE to make room for him, raced three wide through the turn steadily advancing on the leader under coaxing from the three-eighths, swung four then three wide into upper stretch, rallied her ding out RADIO RED a furlong out before seizing command just inside that station, then drifted out in front of RADIO RED a sixteenth from home safely in front while surging home. RADIO RED came out just after the start taking over the lane of MAKER'S CANDY and forcing that rival to alter inwards, chased three wide until tipped out four wide nudging LIFETI ME OF CHANCE briefly five wide allowing the eventual winner into the three path into the turn, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied and was herded out a path or two near the eighth pole, then kept on to the finish altering inwards in the late stages to no avail while along for the place honors. LOOMS BOLDLY showed the way in hand just off the inside, came under coaxing at the three-eighths under challenge from the outside, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat from a pair and relented nearing the sixteenth marker, then weakened in the late stages. WHAT'SUP BRO got bumped at the start by MAKER'S CANDY, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn, angled six wide into upper stretch and weakened. LIFETIME OF CHANCE chased four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, continued four wide into upper stretch, weakened. JACK SON HEIGHTS grew detached at the tail of the field seven paths off the inside when outrun early on, tucked to the two path into the turn coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and made no impact. ETNICO chased five wide down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coaxed along from midway, took the inside route into upper stretch, faltered in the drive.
