ACCEDE attended the pace in hand, launched a bold bid leaving the bend four wide, but flattened and settled for the show. CONDENSATION was forwar dly placed inside, shifted out entering the lane but weakened. OLIVIA TWIST hopped at the start, brushed the gate to get away poorly, bumped with SABRA TUFF justafter the start, moved up along the inside, whee led out leaving the turn, came five wide but failed to threaten. SABRA TUFF broke a step slow and was bumped, settled saving ground, but was never a factor. GRAND LOVE contended betweenhorses through the turn and tired.
