No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry for \$6,000 and shall include all fees. After payment of 1.5% of the total purse to all owners finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the winning owner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. If less than five horses start, the remaining purse will be distributed to the winning owner. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Weights: Three Year Old, 121 lbs. Old er, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2023 all owed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of \$60,000 since November 29, 2022 a llowed 4 lbs.; Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2022-2023 allowed 6 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Total earnings in 2022–2023, as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company, will be used in determining the order of preference. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

TOU CH UP ONASTAR vied for the while three wide, then dueled with inner rival at the top of the bend, shook clear to lead in the early stretch but could not go with Frosted Grace in the late stretch and was second best. KOKOKOMO was unhurried early while saving ground down the backstretch, then bid on the far turn, angled out seven to eight wide to closegap fast to just miss, too late. SONNEMAN saved ground down the backstretch, then bid while three wide on the far turn, rallied mildly in the late stretch and needed more in the end MINE THAT STAR vied for the lead from the inside throughout the first three quarters then tired in the late stretch. SIL VER PROSPECTOR chased the pace while three wide, then rallied on the far turn but did not fire in the stretch. ALLEGE chased the pace from the inside then flattened out in the final furlongs and needed more in the end. LOGICAL MYTH stalked the pace while two wide then moved up to duel with an inner rival throughout the bend was used up and tired in late stretch. ENDORSED chased the pace while four wide, then lost momentum throughout the far turn and stopped. HOLDEN THE LUTE was in a long drive to vie for the lead between rivals, then dropped back on the far turn and stopped.
