SOPRANBASILEA (IRE) lacked speed, circled horses on the far turn, was fanned five deep entering the stretch and rallied outside. BIPARTISANSHIP (GB) , rated down the backstr etch, raced well off the inner rail around the far turn, was behind horses at the head of the stretch and rallied betw een rivals. PRINCESS THEOREM, three wide thefirst turn, racedfour wide when advancing leaving the far turn, br ushed with the winner in upper str etch, moved up to theeighth pole and flattene dout. VERGARA, steadied in close quarters behind TRAFFIC SONG ent ering thefirst turn, chased the pace down the backstretch, gained a two wide lead turning for home and gave way the final furlong. TRAFFIC SONG, three wide entering the first turn, sprinted clear into the backstretch, set the pace nearthe inner rail and gave way approaching the eighth pole. EMINENT VICTOR, in hand along the inner rail down the backstretch, was in tight quarters inside PRINCESS THEOREM entering the far turn, remained along the rail in the stretch and was checked lackingroom inside the three sixteenths pole.
