SHIP CADET hustled from the gate, pressed the pace of VITEMENT from the outside in the two path early on before advancing to duel from the thr ee-eighths, took over narrow command with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch under threat, was displaced from the front straight ened away in the two path into upper str etch, proved no match for the top one while running on safe for the place honors. YO YO CANDY broke out at the start and was corrected, chased along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled out five wide into uppere stretch, kept on under a drive through the str etch to be along for the show honors well clear of the rest. FROSTY THE GIANT coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch and weakened. JUMPINGJAGGERFLASH hustled from the start, chased two to three wide under coaxing from the thr ee-eighths, continued two to three wide for home and tired. VITEMENT hustled from the gate, showed the way early on along the inside under pressure from SHIP CADET to the outside, got engaged in head to head combat with thr ee furlongs to go, y iel ded command at the five-sixteenths and took the insider oute into upper stretch under coaxing, then backed away and faltered in thestretch.
