SADIE BLUEGRASS broke alertly, took back to track the fast early pace and raced outside of rivals into the turn, gained ground two wide along the bend, was roused three deep into the stretch, advanced at mid-stretch and came within aimat the furlong marker, responded to steady urging and closed well approaching the sixteenth-marker, reeled in SASSY NATURE in deep stretch and was up in the final strides to prevail. SASSY NATURE showed good early speed leaving the break, set a fast pace into the turn and drew to a clear lead heading into the bend, set quick fractions to the quarter marker, kept to task while on a clear lead into the stretch, was asked for more nearing the sixteenth-pole, drifted out under firm urging approaching deep stretch, could not hold off the oncoming winner in the final strides and held safely in the end for second. CHANCERY WAY broke out at the start and crow ded BIGSIS LITTLE SIS, chased the fast early pace into the turn, chased outside of the pace setter along the bend and made a mild gain on SASSYNATURE nearing the guarter pole, lost ground to that rival into upper stretch, could not muster a final response in the drive and was outfinished in deep stretch, while holding for third. SMILING MOLLY tracked the fast pace from the inside, saved ground to the quarter marker, mounted a rail bid in upper stretch and came within aim at the furlong marker, lacked the needed late response in the final sixteenth, was outkicked in the final stages and missed for third. BIG SIS LITTLE SIS was crowded at the start by CHANCERY WAY and was off a step slowly, chased from the second flight in the early stages, improved position while two wide along the turn, was coaxed along threewide into the stretch, ran evenly to the furlong pole, rallied in the final stages but needed more in deep stretch. TAMANTARI lacked early speed, saved ground to the top of the lane, tipped two wide for the drive, showed good late interest in the stretch but was unable to threaten. ROUSING JEWEL chased the fast early pace while outside of rivals, was steered three wide into the stretch and did not threaten. MIS CHIE VOUS CURLIN chased from the inside, saved ground to the top of the stretch and did not factor.
