SOARINGFORTHESUN unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied one out from the rail from between rivals through the final turn, and finished two out from the rail in the drive to prove second best. BAKKEN OVERDRIVE away well and vied for the lead from along therail entering the first turn, dictated the pace while racing two wide in the run down the backstretch, held his advantage into the final turn, was overtaken leaving the turn, and finished for wide in the drive to garner a share. CAS CADE BILLY tracked the leader into the backstretch while saving ground along the inside, rallied smartly two wide entering the final turn, and finished evenly five wide in the drive. SET TO SHINE settled off the early pace while racing two out from the rail entering the backside, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. BE QUICK awayalertly and dueled for the lead from the outside of BAKKEN OVERDRIVE entering the first turn, dropped into a tracking trip one out from the rail entering the backstretch, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, but faded over the final furlong.
