After paying 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the purse will be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Wednesday, May 31. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner. This race will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 horses pass the entry box preference will be given to those with the highest weights, with the scale of weights considered. Second preference will be highest lifetime earnings. BELLA BOLLE stalked the pace from the three path into the turn, bid three wide in late turn, got clear with an eighth to go then could not hold off the winner while finishing clear for the place spot. LIL EVIE chased four wide through the turn, had aim on the leaders from mid-track then needed more late. COMPRESSED ENERGY saved ground through the turn when near the back, shifted into the three or four path and was gaining to the end. FORE VER NOTED vied for the lead two wide through the turn, continued a serious contender with an eighth left then gave way. EVERYTHING'S ROSY chased the pacefrom the two path into the turn, checked behind rivals, stayed on and never was a serious threat thereafter. EXPRESS LADY saved ground into the lane, moved up and was not a factor. NO TRUST never afactor while in the four path through the turn. BET CHA set the early pace before the first call, was joined by another into the turn, vied with that one into the lane then faded.
