CLAY'S MOON STONE rated not toofar off the early leaders, raced in range along the rail around the far turn, came two wide entering top stretch, waited momentar ily then dove back to therail, sustained a steady inside bid down the lane and sec ur ed a share. BOSSY MOMENT was not far back up the backstretch, hustled along thr ee to four widearound the far turn, ran on in upper str etch then flattened out. BIG BAD DIVA stalked the pace up the backstretch, continued in range two to three wide around the far turn, came into the lane two wide and failed to move on. LOF THOUSE set a pressured pace, got hea ded midway around the far turn and tir ed in the drive.
