FORT BRAGG stumbled at the start, recovered to settle six paths off the inside down the backstretch just off the pace, advanced into the turn into closest aim then latched on with three furlongs to go, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and hooked up head to head with SAUDI CROWN swinging four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive taking narrow command a furlong from home, battled on gamely trading a minor bump near the sixteenth marker before prevailing by a nostril on the wire. SAUDI CROWN broke in at the start bumping PROVE RIGHT, established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand four then three wide through swift splits, had the aforementioned foe advance outside and came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung three wide into upper stretch bracing for head to head combat, dug in and was collared a furlong out, fought on gamely inside to the finish but was ultimately denied at the end while well clear of the rest. HARRODS BURG four to five wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, continued four to five wide into upper stretch, weakened while along for the show honors. JOEY FRESH WATER chased six then five wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, cornered five wide into upper stretch, tired. ALTERNATE REALITY bobbled at the break, chased four wide down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under coaxing midway, angled in to take the insider outeinto upper stretch, made no impact. PROVE RIGHT got bumped at the start by SAUDI CROWN, who broke inwards, chased just off the inside under coaxing from the three-eighths, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, tired.
