KEY TO SUCCESS a way well and stalked the leader through the str etch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained her position in the run dow nthe backstretch, rallied two wide enter ing the final turn, and closed one out fromthe rail in the drive to hold the place. FORCE TO REKN WITH broke sharply andsettled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail through the stretch the first time, rallied smartly from along the inside entering the final turn, and closed determinedly from along the rail in the drive to just miss the place. MATSQUI settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail through the str etch the first time, rallied from along the inside entering the finalturn, and finished one out from the rail in the drive. LOVEABOVEANDBEYOND tracked the leader from along the inside in the run through the stretch the first time, forced the issue from the outside of AIR FORCE in the run down the backstretch, rallied two wide into the final turn, was unable to keep tabs on the pacesetter entering the final turn, and faded over the final furlong. NEIGHNEIGH stalked the leader through the stretch the first time while racing two out from the rail, maintained her position in the run down the backside, raced two wide into the final turn, but faded over the final furlong. ELLAMEISTER settled off the early pace while racing three wide through the stretch the first time, trailed the field in the run downthe backside, and was unable to mount a late bid.
