TALK TO THE JUDGE sped to the early lead towards the rail, handled outside pressure from FAST TRACKED around the far turn, widened a bit when put to serious asking into the lane, dug in when confronted by LIQUIDATOR in midstretch, kept on tenaciously under strong handling and proved resolute to thew ire. LIQUIDATOR, taken to rate three to four wide after an alert beginning, commence dar un when given her cue past the three eighths, circled fourwidew ith progress into thestretch, ranged up to engage the winner a furl ong out, continued gamely but was kept atbay. ROW SIE EXPRESS, ur ge d to the inside of a rival leav ing the three eighths, shifted out four to five wide in upper str etch and found her beststride through the finalsixte enth. WILLFUL DESIRE prompted the early pace three wide, saved ground stalking mid turn, eased out with aim in upper str etch, gave hard chase past the furlong grounds but one paced from there. FAST TRACKED broke a stepslow, rushed up and quickly gained between runners near the five eighths, forced the paceoutside the winner while under coaxing, saw that one het away a bit enter ing the stretch and faded a touch late. SOL VING PROGRESS pulled early while three to four wide, was riddenalong past the five sixteenths, raced bet ween runners in midstretch then lackeda bid.PRECIOUS AVARY, fractious in the gate, broke awkwardly and found herself well off the early pace, saved ground throughout but failed to generate a serious run. MALIBU MOONSHINE, sluggish from the gate, lagged w ell back under urging, picked things up a bit four wide past the fiv esixteenths, fail ed to kick on nearing mid str etch and w eak ened.
