POPPY FLOWER was brushed at the start and carried out some, settled at the rear, went two then three wide on the turn, came under mild urging late on that bend, was roused five wide into the stretch and lacked the nee ded kick then just missed the show. OUR FLASH DRIVE stumbled awkwardly at the start and was last to commence, moved up under coaxing to race just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved off the rail while asked for her best in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick.
