NEXT stalked the pace on the outside in the two path while traveling comfortably, took over with three furlongs to run, moved clear at the five-sixteenths, extended the advantage while shaken up into upper stretch, was given one light tap of a right-handed crop at the furlong marker, drew away while kept to the task into the final seventy yards and proved much the best under a mild hand-ride to the finish. TIME FOR TROUBLE bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved at the rear while two to three wide, gained under urging on the final turn, shifted four wide before the five-sixteenths, was driven five wide into the stretch, drifted in while outside of a foe inside the furlong marker and safely secured the place. DASH ATTACK broke out and bumped with a foe, settled while inside to the two path, chased on the final turn, was driven four wide into the stretch, drifted in inside the furlong marker and weakened but was clear for the show. THE SKIPPER TOO dropped back early, was reserved in the two path for the first two turns, settled kindly down the backstretch, was roused with a half-mile to run, went four then five wide on the final turn, dropped to the three path outside the quarter-pole and failed to respond. SEAFOAM was coaxed to the front, showed the way on the inside with a clear advantage, lost the lead midway through the final turn and faded. LONE ROCK tugged on the bit under restraint into the first turn, went two to three wide on that bend, settled on the outside in three path, was urged along on the backstretch, dropped back three wide on the final turn and faltered then was eased but walked off. TREASURE TROVE was last to commence then dropped back, saved ground at the rear and also faltered then was eased but walked off.
