SOUPER SUNDAY shadowed the pacesetter, went two to three wide on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, forged clear. FLOWERS 'N BERRIES stalked in behind, shifted to the rail passing the three-eighths marker, tracked the leaders saving ground through the turn, came out at the top of the stretch, fought on late between runners to get up for place. FOOLISH GAMES stalked from outside with good position, went three wide on the turn, came out a bit turning for home, had aim on the leaders, kicked on evenly and was outfinished for second. CARA CARA was quick to the lead, set the pace near the rail with outside pressure, was challenged at the top of the stretch, yielded grudgingly. ANAM CARA was bumped at the break, urged along but lacking early speed, advanced inside heading to the turn, was bumped, steadied and altered out as a rival in front shifted in and the outside foe initiated said contact, was guided back inside, kept on well late. SOUPER SINCLAIR lacked speed racing at the back inside, came out in the stretch, ran on. TAYLORMOON was very reluctant and unruly behind the gate, gotaway well, raced mid-pack going four wide on the turn, kept on evenly. DOMER ALLURE was ridden along in the early going but lacking significant speed, was forced to alter course to avoid arival at the three-eighths, moved back in a bit before swinging out again for the drive, was never near enough to threaten. GIVE ME THE BOOTS chased from outside, went four wide on the turn, came up empty. STRIKE THE POSE raced outside a foe two wide heading into the turn, steadied and bumped with a rival then altered out at the three-eighths, failed to rally. RIFLING bumped a rival at the start, raced in behind foes in the back half of the field, checked sharply and altered out abruptly to avoid runners at the three-eighths, failed to menace.
