HOT CARGO raced betw een runners off the lea der early, eased back and was guided out at the half, went outsidefour thenfive wide on the turn, drifted ina bit nearing mid-stretch, was br ushed late but won the duel for second while not able to get to the winner. ANAM CARA moved forwar dinside runners up the backstretch to gain closer contact to the leader, exchanged a few light bumps in the process, appeared to want to get out enter ing the turn and steadied just slightly to maintain course, came out three wide for the drive, brushed a rival late dueling for place as the leader came out, missed second. SOUPER SINCLAIR began with a few awkward steps anda couple lengths slowly, switched off the inside, put to urging on the turn moving out from four to six wide on that turn, ran on well but too late. FLOWERS 'N BERRIES stalked from outside runners three to four wide, weakened in the str etch. SOUPER SUNDAY exchanged bum ps up the backstretch with the inside foe, stea died slightly at the half then again early on the turn, shifted in and made no late bid.
