CARMELITA'S MAN, taken to rate off the pace and outside arival, steadied lacking some room near the five sixteenths, worked through a seam soon after then altered out four wide for a clear run, closed sharply under right handed encouragement, reeled in the leader with a sixteenth to go then was edging away with good energy at the wire. KINGS RIVER KNIGHT rated forwardly, saved ground into the far turn, came out advancing past the quarter pole, moved up to take command inside the three sixteenths, briefly cleared under a drive past midstretch, dug in when confronted a sixteenth out and finished gamely. NONE ABOVE THE LAW settled off the early pace while saving ground, angled out past the three eighths, circled five wide into the lane, straightened away to advance in mid stretch, switched over to his left lead and continued on with interest. ROYAL 'N RANDO, off the early pace two wide, raced between foes nearing the five sixteenths, swung five to six wide in upper stretch and churned on. JI MMY BLUE JEANS cleared into the first turn, set the pace towards the inside, was collared in upper stretch, ceded command soon after then weakened through the final seventy yards. BALLY'S CHARM stalked the pace three wide, was pushed along nearing the lane, stayed on to a bout mid stretch then faded. IN DI AN PEAK was guided towards the rail soon after the break and settled, awaited room near the quarter pole, came out for the drive and lacked a solid run. BANG FOR YOUR BUCK, off the pace, raced wide leaving the far turn and failed to menace. LARRY'S LEGEND, taken to rate early, raced four wide chasing past the five eighths, failed to kick on past the five sixteenths and weakened. HACKING IT UP, well placed inside, gave way through the lane.
