EDDIE'S NEW DREAM rated in the two path, applied pressure early on the backstretch then dropped back to a stalking position again, engaged the leader from outside midway around the far turn, dueled into the lane, took over in upper stretch and proved best in the final sixteenth. ROSE MADDOX settled three deep in the early going, remained three wide to the stretch, tipped out in thelane, rallied and edged CHANCERY WAY for the place honors. CHANCERY WAY took control from inside, pressured early on the backstretch before moving clearagain, met the challenge from EDDIE'S NEW DREAM past the five-sixteenths pole, maintained a short lead to the top of the stretch, relinquished the lead outside the eight pole, stayed on in deep stretch but got edged for second. MADIHA pulled along the inside into and around the clubhouse turn then had to steady off the heels of the leader at the five-eighths pole, inched closer again stalking from inside, chased a bit off the rail into the lane, moved out and finished evenly late. ULTIMATE HY stalked three then two wide early, three deep up the backstretch, took aim three wide into the lane and also finished evenly in the furlong grounds. HARPER'S GALLOP was keen early under a hold, tracked two wide then moved inside, between into the far turn, angled to the rail late on the bend and could not rally. SUNSHINE BABE raced between rivals at the back early, bothered a bit at the five-eighths pole, coaxed along two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. GLORIOUS SPRING traveled at the back inside a pair of rivals in the early stages, got put in a bit tight at the three-eighths pole and dropped back to last, tipped three wide around the bend and proved no menace.
