CANADIANS WEETHEART was pushed out at the start, regrouped to have a great position tracking the dueling threesome into the turn, waited behind the front three with three furlongs to go, shifted outside to the five path at the top of the stretch, pounced on the leaders at the eighth pole and had enough left in the tank to hold for the victory at the wire. TALK TO YALATER was unhurried to trail down the down the backside, still could see the field running on the turn, swung out gaining momentum seven wide for clear run turning for home and was full of run late surging in deep stretch to make it close at the finish. CLITHEROE (GB) chased the paceinside down the backstretch, continued to hound the frontrunner inside running on the turn, slipped up the fence at the top of the stretch to take command at the furlong marker but had nothing left to give late and yielded to the closers settling for third at the wire inside. HARD EDGE was steadied hard soon after the start, shuffled back losing positions on therail throughout the turn and determinedly finished up bursting between horses in the final sixteenth for a minor share in the end. VANTARSI broke outwards starting, settled near the rear three deep down the back straight, stalked three wide making little advance on the turn, swung out in the six path for the drive to the line and was one paced late but passed tired foes in the final sixteenth. FOREST DRIFT took this field down the backstretch, had a slim advantage on the turn with hounding rivals on either side, was collared in upper stretch and gave way running to the finish. RUN FOR THE HILLS tracked the top pair down the backside, moved three wide to engage for the front at the half, bid in the four path straightening out for the drive, battled up front until the furlong marker and stopped in deep stretch.
