DU JOUR traveled in mid-pack inside a pair of rivals, waited for room on the far turn and brushed with outer foe at the quarter pole, tipped out into the stretch, drew alongside the leaders midstretch and kicked clear in deep stretch. EXAULTED was fractious in the gate, stalked along the inside, saved ground behind the leader on the far turn, lacked room in traffic from upper to midstretch, gained a clear path and rallied inside to get up for second. VISITANT was closest in pursuit to the far turn, engaged the pacesetter from outside around the bend, grabbed the lead briefly in upper stretch before being overtaken by at the eighth pole, stayed on through the final furlong and gote dged for second. IRIDEO (ARG) settled in the two path at the back, moved to the three path on the far turn, swung out into the lane and produced a mild rally, TWIST (FR) hopped a bit at the start, moved to the inside racing towards the rear, moved off the rail on the backstretch, ran into traffic leaving the farturn and had to check, steered out into the clear and also came with a mild laterally. I'M A GAMBLER (IRE) became fractious in the gate, stalked outside a rival early, took aim three wide entering the lane, bid three deep in upper stretch, put a head in front at the eighth pole but weakened in the final sixteenth. COUNT AGAIN tucked inside at the back, coaxed along into the far turn, ran into traffic entering the lane, kept on through the final furlong but failed to threaten. BALNIKHOV (IRE) raced between rivals in mid-pack, got boxed in on the far turn and brushed with the winner at the quarter pole, moved out at the top of the stretch and lacked a late bid. WAR AT SEA traveled outside a pair of rivals off the pace, ridden along through the far turn, spun four wide into the lane, got crowded between rivals in upper stretc hand fa ded. SU MTER sped clear and moved inside, pressured from outside around the farturn, maintained a short lead to the top of the lane, was overtaken in upper stretch and retreated.
