CEILING CRUSHER sent from outside, cleared and crossed over on the first turn, took pressure from outside up the backstretch, cleare d outer rival at the three-eighths pole, roused late on the far turn feeling FLYINGCONNECTION gaining on the outside, responded well by turning that rival away in upper str etch widened in the final sixteenth. FL YING CONNECTION rated in the two path between rivals early, roused along the rail on the far turn, tipped to the two path at the quarter pole, loom ed from outside approaching turning for home, turned away by CEILING CRUSHER in upper stretch and churned on for a clear second. JUSTIQUE was off slow on the inside and lagged behind early, passedtiring rivals four then five wide on the far turn and was along for the show. COFFEE IN BED tucked inside early then moved to the two path around theclubhouse turn, chased in the thr ee path on the second bend and could notrespond when called upon. OCEAN CLUB tracked four deeparound the first turn, chased three wide on the sec ond bend and weakened. PINK ACE broke well and was forwardly placed three then two wide into the first turn, moved up to apply pressure in the middle stages, lost to uch with the leader at the three-eighths pole andfaded out of contention. ANYWHO stalked three deep in the early going, re mained three wide int o the second bend, dropped back on the far turn and tired. INFINITE DIAMOND stalked the leader along the rail inside rivals, dropped back in the middle stages, eased on the far turn and down the stretch, ev entually crossing the wire and wal ked off.
