FLATTERY steadied into the first turn when losing her path, patiently handled while saving ground into backstretch, dropped back bit then taken off the rail roused early on the second bend, shifted out and advanced quickly three then four wide, bid four deep and between rivals into the stretch, kicked cleared past eighth marker then held off late inside bid of runner-up. LOTERIE (IRE) reserved and crossed over early to secure the inside, chased along the rail, came off the fence early on the backstretch, moved up between foes early on the final bend, found traffic and caught behind wall of rivals, paused and checked slightly awaiting room later around the turn and into the stretch, finally shifted to rail past eighth pole, found seam along the fence inside TAMBO and surged late from the inside but could not collar the winner. ANGIOLL ETA (IRE) taken offearly pace and chased from the inside. saved ground on the far turn and lacked room at the quarter pole checking momentarily, came out into the stretch, rallied some from the outside and moved away from others to gain third. TAMBO tracked pacesetter from two path, moved up on second bend. challenged from between rivals entering the stretch but failed to sustain effort. CAIL IN DANA chased on two wide path, closed gap on leader into last turn, moved up and engaged leaders on two path and between foes into the lane but failed to sustain effort in the drive. AURATIUM chased two to three wide on the clubhouse turn, caught four wide around the second turn, for ced out fur ther entering the stretch and lacked needed late punch. DOUBLE BAY (IRE) stalked from the inside, was pulling bit in middle stages from the inside, boxed in with nowhere to go through the far turn and upper stretch and did not threaten. BOSSY BRUIN GAL sent up three wide early to grab early lead then angled inward, was rated on clear lead through the backstretch, had that lead dissolve on the last turn, relinquished control into the lane and weakened.
